In Hand Section (for all to compete) – Starts 9:30am

- Class 1** Show Ring Experience (Combination not placed 1st before in an in-hand show)
- Class 2** Handsome Gelding/Colt/Stallion
- Class 3** Prettiest Mare/ Filly
- Class 4** M&M (will be split to small and large if enough entries)
- Class 5** Best Coloured (Including palomino/cremello/dun etc)
- Class 6** Youngstock (3 yrs and under)
- Class 7** Cob (open to all cobs including traditional)
- Class 8** Home Produced
- Class 9** Local Horse/ Pony within 25 miles
- Class 10** Combination - Best Turnout

Junior Section – Under 16 years Only

- Class 11** Show Ring Experience (Combination not placed 1st before in an in-hand show)
- Class 12** Junior Handler
- Class 13** Best Pony/Horse
- Class 14** Pony the Judge would most like to take home

In Hand Championships

Junior Handler Championship

anyone under 16 years who has been 1st or 2nd in class 1-14

Novelty Championship

anyone who has placed 1st or 2nd in class 1, 2, 3, 9, 11, 13, 14

In Hand Championship

anyone who has placed 1st and 2nd in class 1 – 14

Supreme In Hand Championship

Anyone who has been Champion or Reserve in the three above championships is eligible to compete.

Exact class times are not possible due to entries on the day but we always post current classes on our WhatsApp group so make sure you have joined ahead of the show.

Ridden Section

- Class 15** Lead Rein (Split into those who have been riding less/ longer than a year if sufficient entries).
- Class 16** Have a go first ridden - there will be an individual trot round and then you can do as you wish in your individual show, please note extra points will not be given for cantering (**please enter in the spirit intended for this class or it spoils it for those genuinely having ago**).
- Class 17** First Ridden
- Class 18** Ridden Walk & Trot – Novice Rider - This class is for **genuine novice/ inexperience riders** who cannot canter of any age. There will be no go round in a group but an individual trot and then each person pulled to do their own show in walk and trot only.
- Class 19** Novice Horse (no group canter)
- Class 20** Ridden Walk & Trot (lead reins permitted)
- Class 21** Best Ridden Gelding/Stallion/
- Class 22** Best Ridden Mare
- Class 23** Ridden M&M
- Class 24** Open Ridden

Ridden Championships

Tiny Tots Ridden Champion

anyone 6 years and under placed 1st to 6th in classes 15, 16, 17, 18,
20

Junior Ridden Champion

anyone under 16 years who has placed 1st and 2nd in class 15, 16, 17

Ridden Champion

Anyone placed 1st or 2nd in classes 15-24

Supreme Ridden Championship

Anyone who has been Champion or Reserve in the three above championships is eligible to compete.

Exact class times are not possible due to entries on the day but we always post current classes on our WhatsApp group so make sure you have joined ahead of the show.

Rules

1. The judges decision is final. The organiser also reserves the right to substitute a judge should it be necessary.
2. Please do not muck out on the showground. Hay to be kept in lorry/trailer and all rubbish to be taken home or placed in bins provided.
3. Animals are NOT to be tied to the side of vehicles/trailors/ lorries etc and left unattended. If leaving your animal please place them back in you transport vehicle with the ramp up, due to main gates being open to prevent animals escaping/ getting lose.
4. Please follow any parking signs/directions from officials
5. Objections must be lodged in writing to the show secretary within 30 minutes of the class ending along with a £20 fee. This fee will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
6. Unacceptable behaviour from competitors/ owners/ spectators will not be tolerated by the show officials. All competitors/ owner/ spectators should follow instructions from officials. Unacceptable behaviour could result in you being asked to leave the showground and the possibility of being banned from future events.
7. Current standard riding hats must be worn at all times while mounted on the showground and also by children 16 years and under in the ring.
8. All horse/ponies ridden must be 4 years old or over.
9. Passports must be produced upon request.
10. The Equestrian Box Events and the event venue, nor any of its officers, servants or assistants shall in any way be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or property in connection with or arising from this show. It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors or their servants shall indemnify the Equestrian Box Events, its officials, servants or assistants against all action, proceedings, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show. All exhibitors should ensure that they have sufficient third-party/public liability insurance. Each entry form must be signed as having accepted these conditions by a person over the age of 18. By entering online, we accept this as you signing to confirm agreement to the above.
11. Refunds/ credits will not be issued for any classes/events that you are unable to take part in after payment has been made.
