- Class 4** M&M (will be split to small and large if enough entries)
- Class 5** Best Coloured (Including palomino/cremello/dun etc)
- Class 6** Senior Handler (17yrs plus)
- Class 7** Youngstock (3 yrs and under)
- Class 8** Best Pony
- Class 9** Best Horse
- Class 10** Best Solid Colour

In Hand Championship all 1st and 2nd places from class 1-10

Junior Section – Under 16 years Only – Not before 11:30am

In Hand

- Class 11** Show Ring Experience (Combination not placed 1st before in an in hand show)
- Class 12** Junior handler 10yrs and under
- Class 13** Junior Handler 11yrs – 16yrs

Ridden

- Class 14** Lead Rein
- Class 15** Just off lead rein/have a go first ridden (please enter in the spirit intended for this class)
- Class 16** First Ridden
- Class 17** Open Ridden

These classes are for **genuine novice/ inexperience riders** of any age. There will be no go round in a group but an individual trot and then each person pulled to do their own show in walk and trot only.

Open Ridden – For Advanced/Competitive Riders

All entries will be expected to do a canter in the go round and individual show unless the walk and trot class and the Novice Horse.

Class 23 Ridden Local Horse/Pony within 25 miles

Class 24 Best Gelding/Stallion Ridden

Class 25 Best Ridden Mare

Rules

1. The judges decision is final. The organiser also reserves the right to substitute a judge should it be necessary.
2. Please do not muck out on the showground. Hay to be kept in lorry/trailer and all rubbish to be taken home or placed in bins provided.
3. Animals are NOT to be tied to the side of vehicles/trailors/ lorries etc and left unattended. If leaving your animal please place them back in you transport vehicle with the ramp up, due to main gates being open to prevent animals escaping/ getting lose.
4. Please follow any parking signs/directions from officials
5. Objections must be lodged in writing to the show secretary within 30 minutes of the class ending along with a £20 fee. This fee will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
6. Unacceptable behaviour from competitors/ owners/ spectators will not be tolerated by the show officials. All competitors/ owner/ spectators should follow instructions from officials. Unacceptable behaviour could result in you being asked to leave the showground and the possibility of being banned from future events.
7. Current standard riding hats must be worn at all times while mounted on the showground and also by children 16 years and under in the ring.
8. All horse/ponies ridden must be 4 years old or over.
9. Passports must be produced upon request.
10. The Equestrian Box Events and the event venue, nor any of its officers, servants or assistants shall in any way be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or property in connection with or arising from this show. It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors or their servants shall indemnify the Equestrian Box Events, its officials, servants or assistants against all action, proceedings, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show. All exhibitors should ensure that they have sufficient third-party/public liability insurance. Each entry form must be signed as having accepted these conditions by a person over the age of 18. By entering online, we accept this as you signing to confirm agreement to the above.
11. Refunds/ credits will not be issued for any classes/events that you are unable to take part in after payment has been made.
